

As a result of the destruction caused by World War I and the Spanish Flu, countless spirits have become stranded in our world. Tomas, the young, wandering, post mortem photographer, ends up in a small Hungarian village during the freezing winter of 1918, after meeting a ten year-old orphan girl, Anna. But as he becomes more closely acquainted with the life of the place, he feels increasingly like he must escape it. The noises in the night, the village enveloped in hostility, the strange deaths, and the shadowy figures appearing in his photographs all prompt him to leave as soon as possible. Only a vision in the night and the certainty that ghosts exist, makes Tomás return to the village, his conscience and desire for action awakened

He decides that with the help of the instruments at his disposal, he will investigate the ghosts' intentions and will find a way to get free of them. The little girl accompanies Tomás's exciting exploration through all its dangers, but they find no clear answers; all the while, the spirits wreak greater havoc as each moment passes.







SYNOPSIS

A husband losing faith in his marriage after an assault. Dénes thinks of himself as liberal and broadminded until he confronts his own hidden limits. Dénes and Nóra have been trying to adopt a child for some years. Finally, they are about to receive a baby in a matter of weeks but after celebrating with their friends, the couple have an argument and separate on their way home. The day after, Nóra tells Dénes that after she got off the last bus, she was raped by a stranger. Lack of evidence, injury or witnesses make it difficult for the police to take action. Then when Nóra's description is used to find the alleged perpetrator, a high-school teacher, his and Nóra's testimonies stand against each other, equally credible and totally opposing. The police cannot prove sexual assault has taken place, so they close the case.



Kata Tordai is thirty-two, a former hospital assistant, who only wanted to write her anger away, but in the end, she became a spiritual/self-help star author with hundreds of thousands of fans.

One random morning, András and Kata run into each other on the way to see a publisher. It is hate at first sight, and only made worse by the fact that András's new novel gets rejected by the publisher because of their interest in Kata.

The two meet again at an awards gala, and at the night's end, Kata posts a photo of the two of them on her Instagram profile. Tens of thousands of fans see the picture, and to András's great surprise, the post prompts his book to start selling. His advertising instincts kick in, and he decides to exploit this serendipitous marketing strategy and ride the waves of Kata's success for his own gain. As they become closer, their initial antipathy slowly turns into mutual attraction. Kata has a liberating effect on András, while he seems to help Kata confront herself, which is just what she needs.

By the time scheming András gets the public to believe he and Kata are actually in a relationship, both of them have true feelings for the other.
